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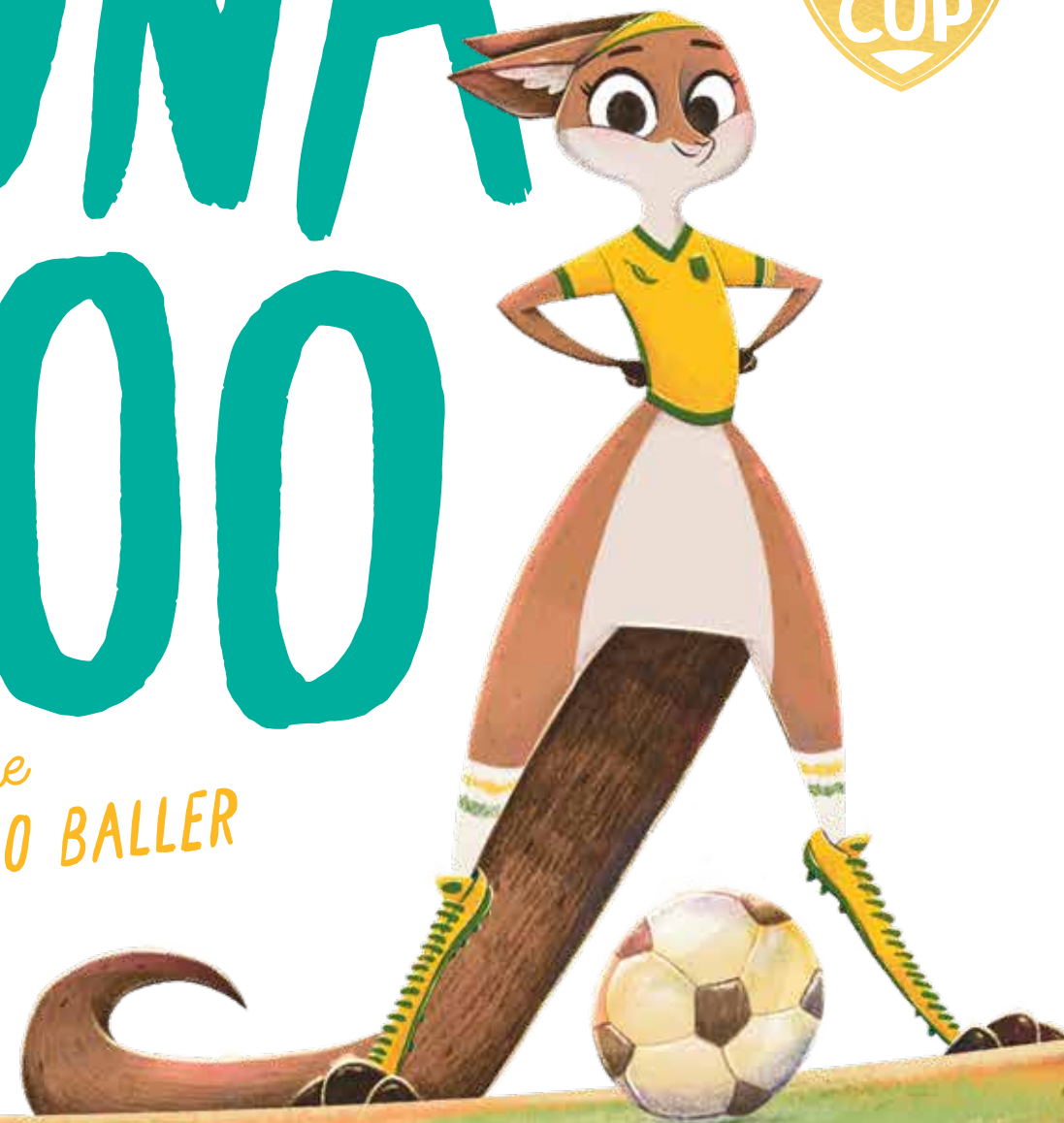
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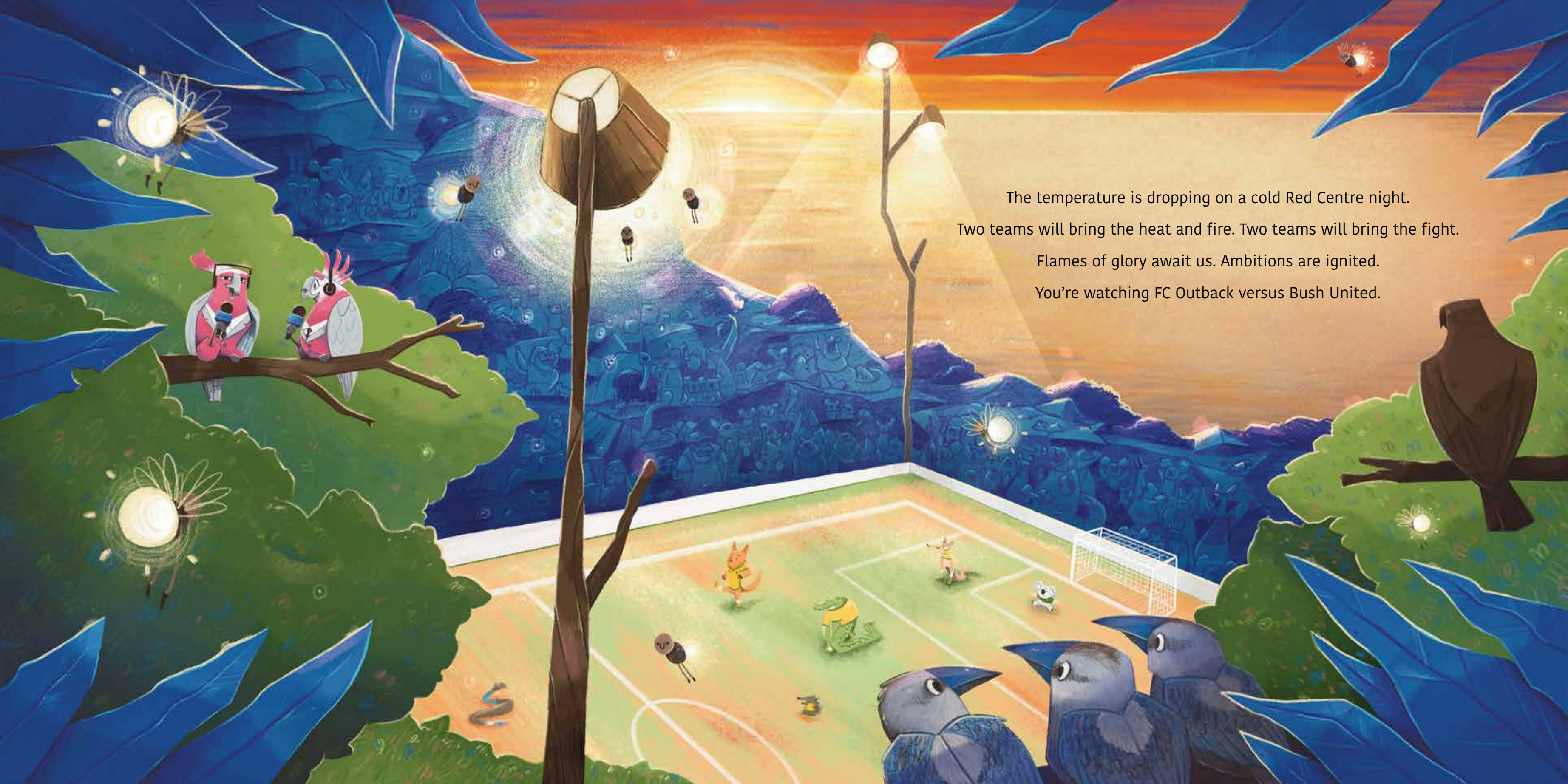
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The temperature is dropping on a cold Red Centre night.

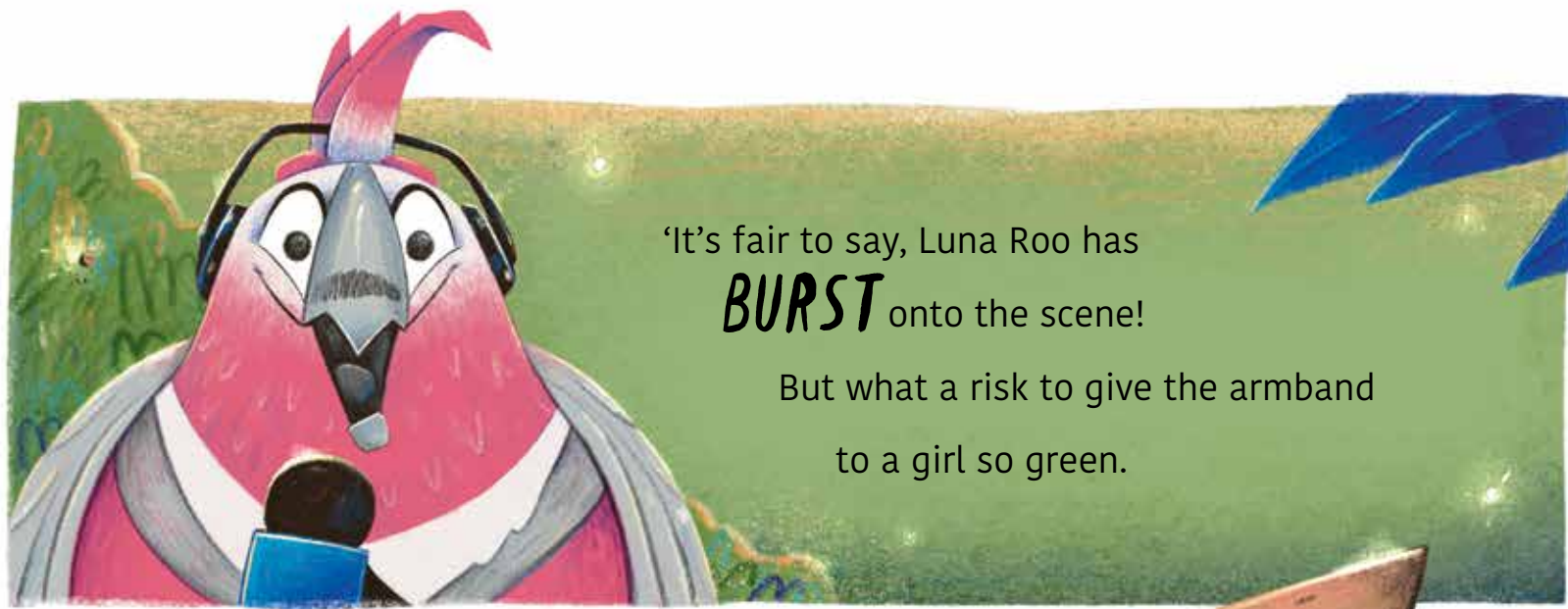
We’re commentating for Flocks Sports.

with their deadly, swift attack.



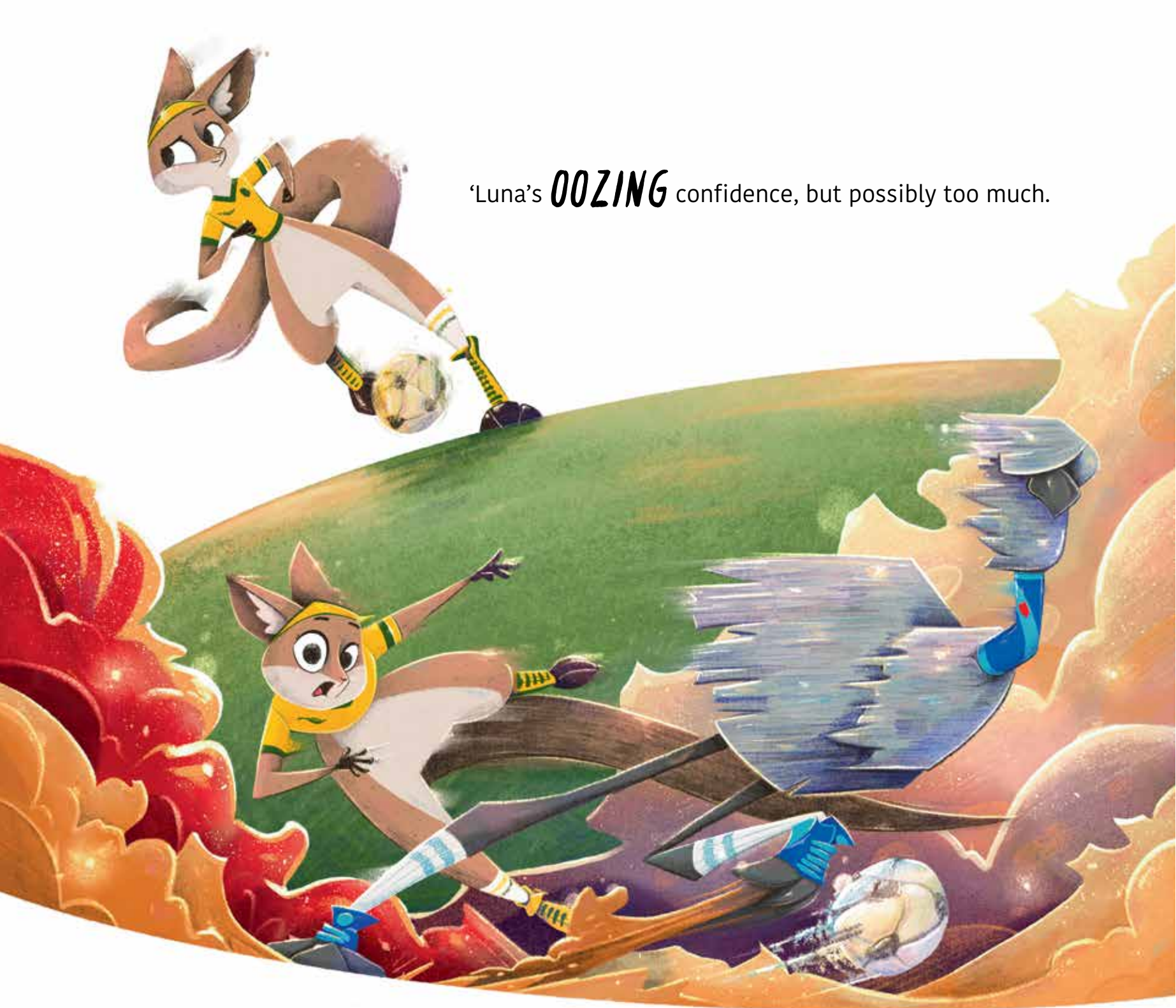
The **BROWN SNAKE** is up front, teamed with the **RED-BELLIED BLACK**.

GOOOOOO OAAALL!!



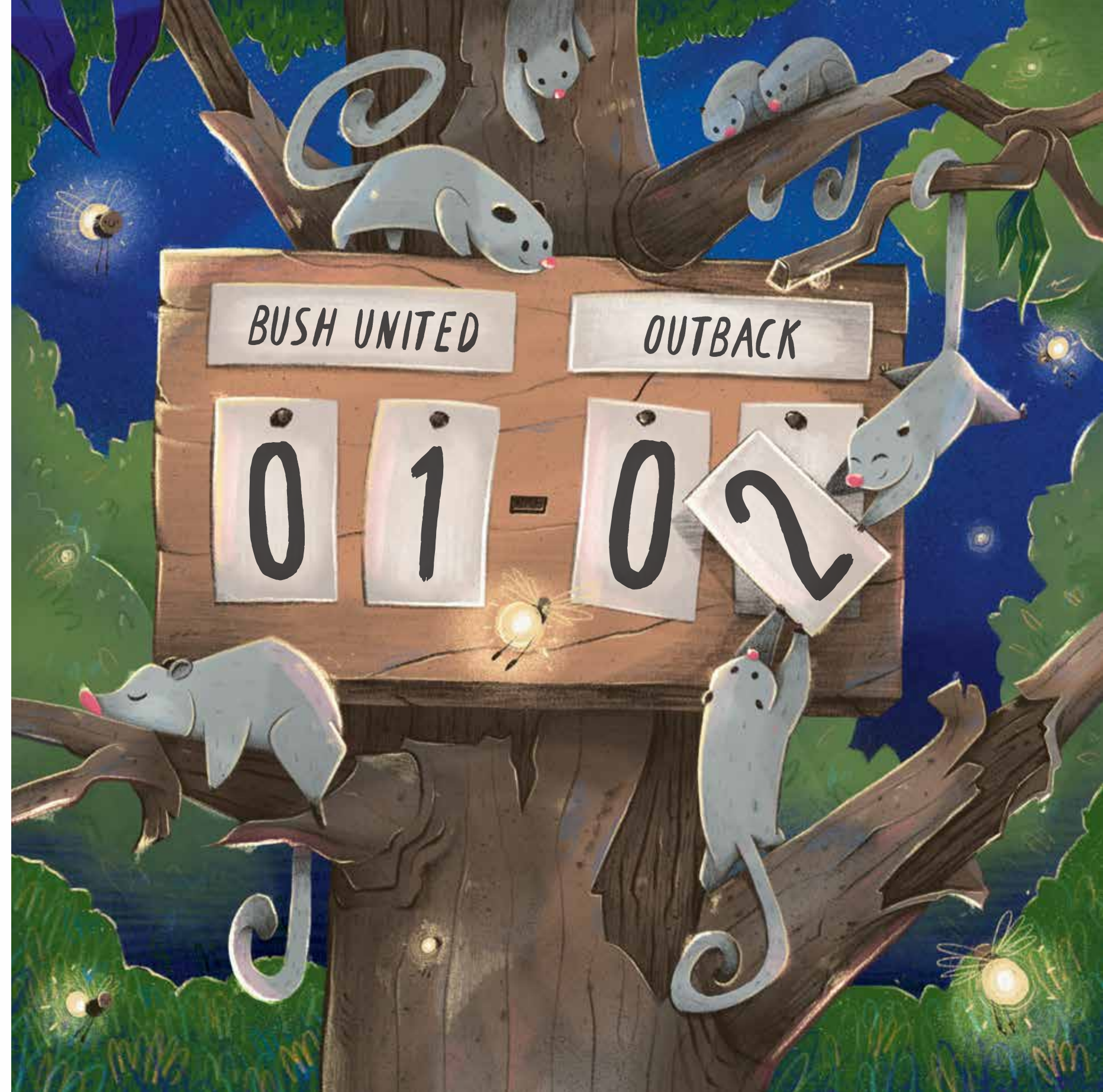
Luna stops the celebrations.

THIS IS UNBELIEVABLE, JEFF!’



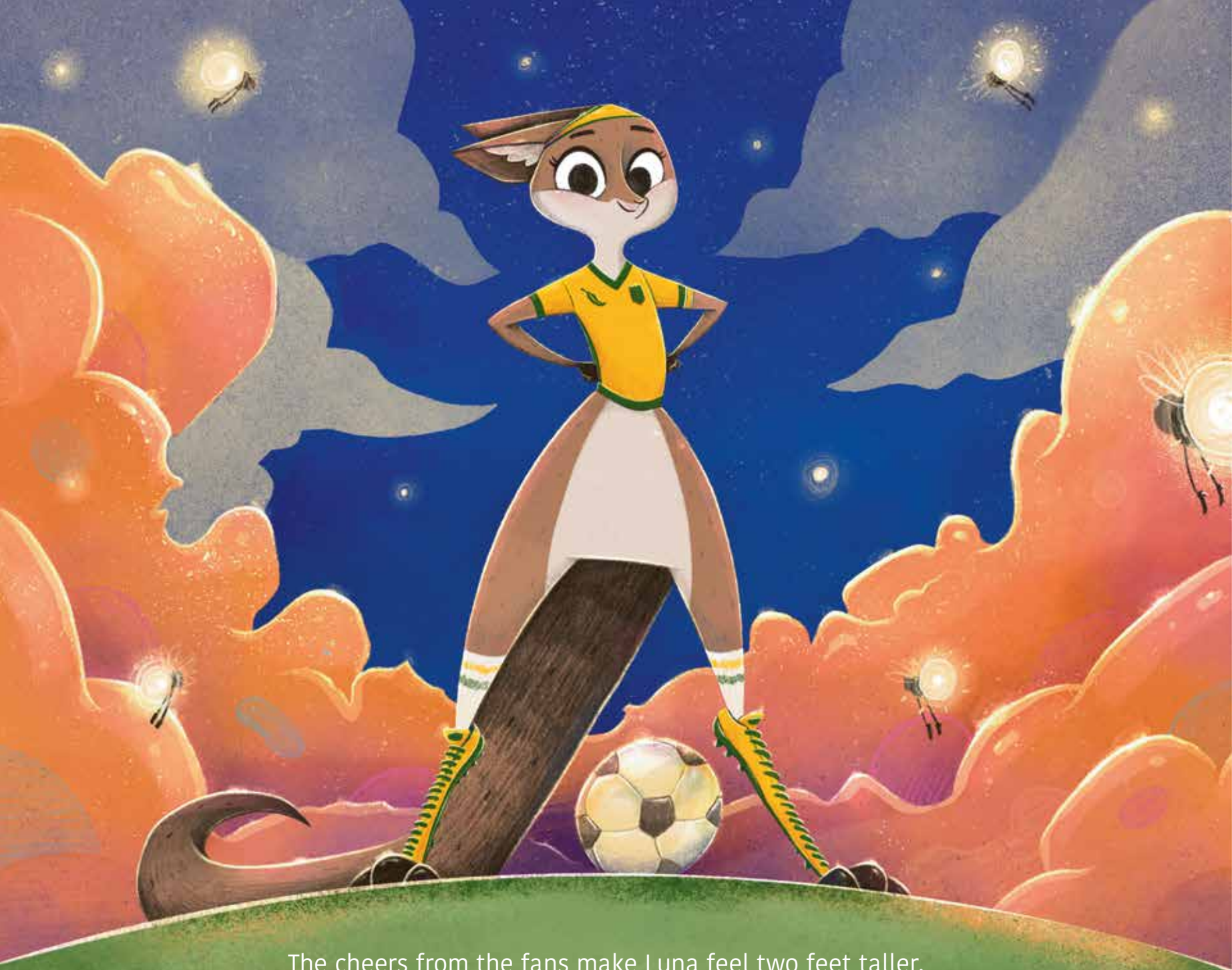
'As full-time whistle blows,

The cheers from the fans make Luna feel two feet taller.

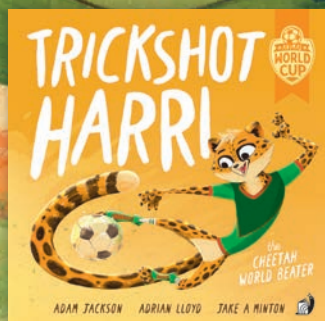
She has now proven herself to be the Kangaroo baller.

Rookie captain *LUNA ROO* leaves nothing on the pitch as she leads FC Outback in a thrilling face-off against *BUSH UNITED*.

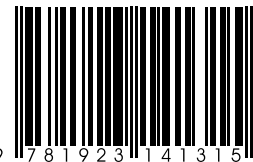
