



Fixing our courts

- Funding for new criminal courtrooms and revamp of Adelaide Youth Court
- New interview and witness rooms that protect the safety and dignity of court users
- A commitment to meet minimum domestic violence safety standards for court infrastructure

Addressing unmet legal need

- Increased legal aid and legal assistance funding, specifically targeted at those below or near the poverty line, and those in regional areas
- Increased legal aid rates to boost the number of private practitioners able to take on legal aid work

Enhancing access to justice in the courts

- Abolish court transcript fees
- Funding to increase the number of properly trained court interpreters

Crime reduction measures

- A significant increase in funding for youth diversionary programs
- Build bail and post-release accommodation to help those exiting prison transition back into the community
- Increase access to prison rehabilitation programs

Legislative transparency and accountability

- Establish a Scrutiny of Bills and Legislation Committee within Parliament
- Funding to strengthen the legislative review functions of Parliamentary Committees

Resolving building disputes quicker

- Establish a Building Tribunal within SACAT
